This is a local project we have supplied timber for, and was built by Seth from Tend & Mend.







### What timber is required?





Tanalised 6 x 2, 8 x 2, and 2 x 2 Planed Gauged Timber has been used.



The posts are 4 x 4 planed tanalised and could be produced from either eased four corners homegrown timber or joinery unsorted redwood.



All cut ends would need to be treated with <u>Barrettine Cut End Preservative</u> also available from our shop. For fixings <u>Timberlok screws</u> were used.

Painted or Stained finishes really enhance the timber. This can be applied on top of Tanalised timber.

Siberian Larch and Western Red Cedar timber are both suitable timbers for this style and available from our online shop or contact




